Eldon House Partners with TD Friends of the Environment Foundation

Eldon House Heritage Site and Gardens is proud to partner with TD on two new projects for the spring of 2025.

Eldon House is happy to announce that we have received funding for two projects from TD Friends of the Environment Foundation. These projects, both which will commence in the spring, further our commitment to environmental education and transforming Eldon House into a downtown oasis for Londoners and tourists.

The first project, "Back to our Roots", will revitalize the East Garden, reintroducing native plant species and infrastructure including information on the grounds. Additional education through social media and our website will provide guidelines to introducing native plant species, and a speaker series will launch in late spring to engage the community in this exciting project.

Our second project, "Exploring our Roots", aims to provide education about London's history and the natural landscape by hosting education programs for elementary and secondary students. Bussing subsidies provided by the TD Friends of the Environment Foundation, will remove barriers to access, and allow students to come to site and engage with history and outdoor education. Teachers will be able to apply for a spot by emailing our Program Coordinator starting in late February.

Eldon House is very excited by this wonderful opportunity and will continue providing updates on the progression of our projects via our website and social media.
